Methodology



WHAT

Public Opinion strategies conducted a national telephone survey of actual voters on election day to measure 2020 voters' views on key issues.



WHEN

The survey was conducted on November 3, 2020.



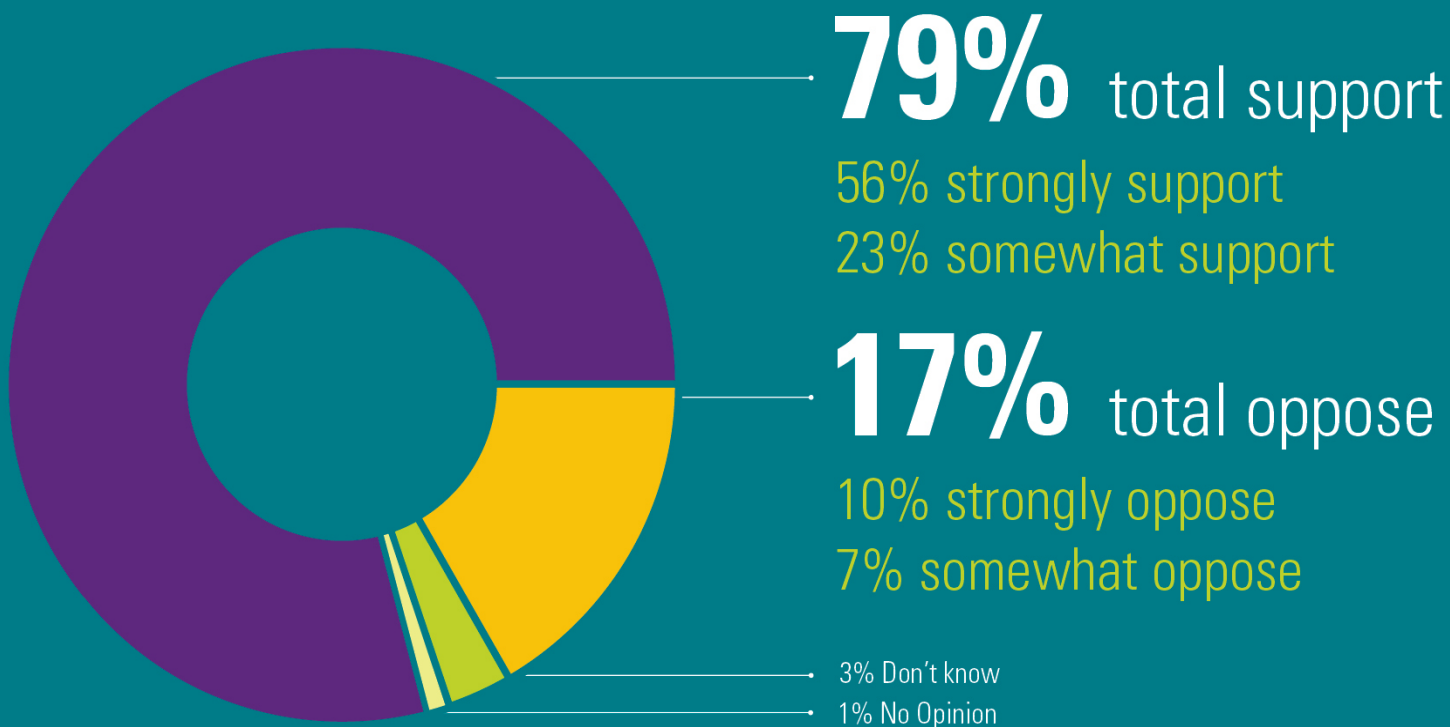
WHO

The survey was conducted among N=800 actual voters.

The margin of error for a sample size of N=800 is $\pm 3.46\%$.

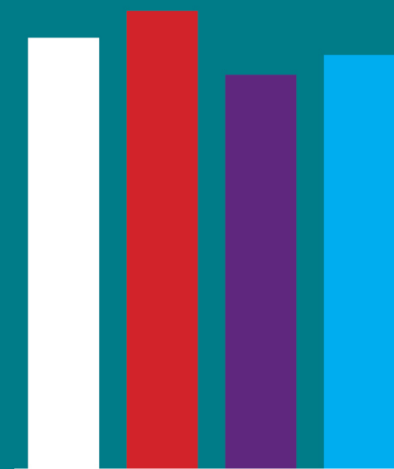
